

## INSTRUMENT OF SUB-DELEGATION Personal Injury Commission Act 2020

Under sub-section 18(4) of the *Personal Injury Commission Act 2020* (**Act**), I, Rodney Parsons, Division Head, Workers Compensation Division of the Personal Injury Commission (**Commission**),
