RESOLUTION #2 of 2025

Pursuant to section 19(7) of the *Personal Injury Commission Act 2020*

On 30 January 2025, the Rule Committee of the Personal Injury Commission of New South Wales (**Committee**) resolved unanimously by the 11 members present (with 2 members absent) as follows:

1. To instruct the Parliamentary Counsel's Office (PCO) to address the lacuna in rule 65(b) by clarifying the definition of the "appropriate decision-maker" for "other applicable proceedings" to include Merit Reviewers, Merit Review Panels, Medical Review Panels and Medical Appeal Panels, in addition to the President (and his delegates).
2. To instruct the PCO to amend rule 67D(2) to reflect that "medical assessors" are also able to rely on the rule, in addition to the above decision-makers.

The President voted for the resolution set out above.
