Rule Committee of the Personal Injury Commission RESOLUTION #2 of 2025

Pursuant to section 19(7) of the Personal Injury Commission Act 2020

On 30 January 2025, the Rule Committee of the Personal Injury Commission of New South Wales (**Committee**) resolved unanimously by the 11 members present (with 2 members absent) as follows:

- To instruct the Parliamentary Counsel's Office (PCO) to address the lacuna in rule 65(b) by clarifying the definition of the "appropriate decision-maker" for "other applicable proceedings" to include Merit Reviewers, Merit Review Panels, Medical Review Panels and Medical Appeal Panels, in addition to the President (and his delegates.
- 2. To instruct the PCO to amend rule 67D(2) to reflect that "medical assessors" are also able to rely on the rule, in addition to the above decision-makers.

The President voted for the resolution set out above.
